Rowcroft Hospice and Torbay & South Devon NHS Trust have been running the End of Life Care Ambassador Programme since 2018 training staff within South Devon from the hospice, acute trusts, care homes and community services. Ambassadors make workplace changes to improve care by attending taught days and receiving peer and mentored support to design and run a project and raise awareness about Dying Matters.
