When the hospice first opened its doors back in 1982, there was only enough money in the pot for it to stay open for three months.

It was in no small way due to the Friends of Rowcroft that the hospice not only stayed open but has been able to develop its services to those we see today.

Since 1982, they have raised over £3 million, helping Rowcroft to provide specialist care to many thousands of local people living with progressive life-limiting illnesses.

Every year, the Friends organise a variety of fundraising events; from coffee mornings to concerts, raffles to fetes, and they sell Christmas cards and merchandise across the 300 sq miles of Rowcroft's catchment area.
