Key roles and responsibilities:

- 1. Provide specialist nursing care to patients in their own homes. Carry out assessments, arrange care plans, monitor symptoms and adjust medication with the guidance of the Sister and working closely with HCAs and Senior HCAs, provide personal care to patients.
- 2. Liaise with other community agencies to provide the best care.
- 3. Provide emotional support to families.
- 4. Verify deaths and provide care after death with the support of the Healthcare Assistants and Senior Healthcare Assistants.
- 5. Promote a culture of continuous learning and development and wellbeing. Identify your own learning and development needs and ensure your mandatory and essential training is up to date. Provide education both internally and externally. Support through mentoring and appraisal junior members of the team and students. Take part in clinical supervision, play an active part in team meetings. Help to create an environment that is continually critically questioning practice and promoting learning.
