Strength to strength

Thanks to the most incredible efforts of our local community (including amazing people like you!) our financial stability continues to strengthen, and we are continuing to care for the same number of patients as in previous years, despite the restructuring of our services in 2016.

Chief Executive Mark Hawkins is delighted, but warns against complacency: "Our vision is to make every day the best it can be for people living with life-limiting illnesses in South Devon. However, our local population is ageing and facing increasingly complex conditions. Over the coming years, we must continue to build sustainable income streams in order to ensure our services remain free and available for generations to come."

Music to our ears

We are delighted to announce that funding for our much-loved Music Therapy service is once again being provided by the hospice. The service, which is hugely popular with our patients and their loved ones, was cut when we suffered our funding shortfall in 2016.

Music Therapist, David Holmes, sourced external funding for his post while the hospice regained financial stability, and is now delighted the service will once again be funded by donations to Rowcroft. He said: "It is a great relief and very satisfying that we have managed to save the Music Therapy post and its contribution to the holistic care at Rowcroft."

New Reiki Therapist

We have secured a grant from the Sam Buxton Sunflower Healing Trust to fund a dedicated Reiki Therapist. Hilda Kalap will work within our Complementary Therapy team seeing a minimum of six patients and their family members a week. She said: "Reiki aims to bring about balance in mind, body and spirit. Through its profound relaxation effect it can help with pain and nausea, relieve worry and anxiety and treat needle phobias - a lot of the symptoms and situations I expect to come across working with patients and families at Rowcroft."

The new Chelston shop will cater for twice the number of people as Churston and will have an alcohol licence. Caroline added: "We want the shop to become a hub for the local community; perfect for working lunches, lazy catch ups or even an after work tipple."

Sustainable thinking

We are looking to introduce a number of measures to make our shops more environmentally friendly.

Costs are currently being acquired for more sustainable sources of packaging, paper bags, and re-usable cups to stock for sale in our coffee shops.

Rowcroft's Retail Area Manager, Leigh Hanley, explained: "We feel a sense of responsibility to reduce our environmental impact and source more sustainable alternatives for current practices. Such measures haven't been widely adopted by the charity retail sector so far, but we feel very optimistic about this opportunity."

Behind-the-scenes

Centre of attention

Every year our Distribution Centre in Newton Abbot sorts more than 650 tonnes of donations, processing and allocating them to our 16 shops across South Devon. Since opening, it has seen profits across Rowcroft's retail department rise by 85% to more than £500,000 in 2017. Now's your chance to find out what really goes on behind the scenes, and meet one of our dedicated sorting volunteers.

Rowcroft's Distribution Centre is located on Brunel Industrial Estate, Newton Abbot. Housed within its walls is an average of 12 tonnes of weekly donations including electrical goods, clothes, furniture... even mobility scooters. "We are incredibly fortunate that the biggest challenge we face," explains the centre's manager, Paul O'Callaghan, "is the large volume of donations we receive on a daily basis, and how to process all the stock with the manpower we have."

At the centre, a team of staff and volunteers sort donations of clothing and bric-a-brac and PAT test electrical items. "In 2017/2018 sales of our electrical items alone generated £95,000 for the hospice," says Paul.

Once processed, all donated items are sent out to different shops, based on each shop's customer profiles and stock requirements. Paul explains: "In a nutshell, we send the right stock to the right shops so we can get the best price for our donations." Rowcroft's shops are also able to order stock from the Distribution Centre, "We send out around 600 boxes of stock every week," explains Paul.

As well as sorting, processing and delivering stock, the Distribution Centre also takes responsibility for selling on any excess stock to other charities or rag merchants, which generates around

£78,000 per year. Meanwhile sorters identify certain niche and collectable items that are sent to the hospice's Ebay department, generating around £90,000 in sales.



Van drivers based at Distribution Centre made more than 3,000 visits to Rowcroft's shops last year

The Centre is also home to one of Rowcroft's three Furniture Outlets, which last year generated more than £120,000, and is a base for six van drivers, who collect large donations of furniture from properties across South Devon.

Caroline Wannell, Rowcroft's Head of Retail, said: "Our Distribution Centre has become an integral part of the functioning of Rowcroft's expanding retail department; we currently estimate that 60% of sales in all of Rowcroft's shops have come from the centre. In the years to come we hope it will drive an even greater income from the sale of people's generous donations, and help many more families benefit from Rowcroft's services."

Meet Distribution Centre Volunteer Helen

How long have you volunteered at Rowcroft's Distribution Centre? Since November 2014. My father had spent three weeks at Rowcroft back in 2007 and I wanted to give something back. I like the idea of recycling, re-using and reducing waste, which is what Rowcroft's Distribution Centre is all about.

Can you describe your role?

I sort all the donations of bedlinen, curtains, towels, vintage linen and lace, table linen, covers and throws, and the cushions. I take pride in the responsibility I have been given, plus I know that it is all making money for the hospice.

What do you enjoy about being a volunteer?

Volunteering is flexible, and gives me experience in a different field to what I do in the rest of my life.

Funding the equipment we need to provide this level of care is a constant challenge. We only buy what we absolutely need but even so, the cost of funding vital equipment is £11,000.

With 12 beds on our Inpatient Unit, equipment is in constant use. We currently need to replace the following items:

- a mattress costing £2,000
- a syringe driver costing £1,000
- four reclining chairs costing £2,000 each

As you can imagine, every day and night is precious for our patients and their families, and we want to ensure that when they come into our Inpatient Unit they receive the best care possible with the equipment we, and they need.


