For the purposes of this guide we are using the term 'event' to cover any fundraising activity in aid of Rowcroft Hospice.




TOP TIPS

- Decide on a target; it will give you a focus and might encourage people to donate more if they see you're close to achieving your target.
- Give yourself plenty of time to plan your event and to raise funds the sooner you start thinking about raising the pounds, the more time you'll have to collect them.
- Set up an online donation page through Virgin Money Giving or Just Giving so that people can donate online. It's quick, easy and means you don't have to chase people to collect sponsorship money! You can also share your page on your social media sites.
- Speak to local businesses, radio stations or newspapers about sponsorship you could even send a press release about your event to the local papers.
- Nowadays many companies are keen to demonstrate their corporate social responsibility through supporting charities with match funding. Ask your manager if they will match your fundraising this can make a huge difference!

Keep it Safe and Legal

It is important that you ensure any fundraising activity you do for Rowcroft Hospice is safe and legal. Certain fundraising activities require that you take out a license to hold them. Below you will find some helpful advice to get you started. If you have any questions at all, please call us on 01803 217628.



Raffles and lotteries:

Small raffles that take place at your event are acceptable, as long as the ticket selling and announcement of the winners are held on the same day. Raffles have their own regulations so if you're planning to sell tickets prior to the event, please get in touch with the Fundraising Team for more advice

Collection licences:

To collect in any public place you will need a collector's licence which you can apply for from your local authority. You will also need a licence for the following activities: sale of alcohol, extended hours, provision of food and drink, copyright and royalties for drama or film shows, collecting money or selling goods in a public place.

Health and safety:

Rowcroft Hospice really appreciates everything you do to raise money for families living with a life-limiting illness, but we want you to do this safely. It is with this in mind that we advise you to identify any potential accidents or hazards before you decide to hold the event by completing a risk assessment. Rowcroft Hospice doesn't accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury as a result of your fundraising event or activity. It's essential you make sure your event is safe for all concerned. Other points to remember:

Let us know about the event you're planning and we can make sure you're properly supported. If you would like to use the Rowcroft Hospice logo on anything contact the Fundraising Team for advice as we need to approve all uses of our logo on any materials printed.

Gift Aid

giftaid it Don't forget to Gift Aid your donations wherever possible! For those who pay UK tax, this can increase their donation by 25%. We can provide you with sponsorship forms or Gift Aid envelopes to help make that donation go even further. Just make sure that everyone fills in their own address details and that the form is completed with clear writing. There are restrictions on claiming Gift Aid for challenge events, so please speak to us for further information.

In-Memory Giving:

Rowcroft's in-memory events are open to all, not just those touched by our care. Dedicate a flower in the Meadow of Memories, a light on the Tree of Light or place your loved one's name in Rowcroft's Book of Light.
